We will then notify the patient and coordinate a movement disorders evaluation with Dr. Revuelta.

To be a surgical candidate, the Parkinson patient should have:

- □ Idiopathic Parkinson's Disease, responsive to levodopa.
- □ Fluctuations in levodopa response, often with off time and/or dyskinesia.
- Lack of dementia.
- □ Lack of treatment refractory psychiatric diagnosis.

In dystonia, DBS is only indicated in the idiopathic form, not disorders secondary to cerebral palsy, trauma or anoxia.
